

Patient Information regarding Contact Lens ' *fittings* '

A regular eye exam generates an Rx for glasses only.

When a patient wants a contact lenses exam, a ' *fitting* ' is required.

There is an additional charge for this time which is called a ' *fitting fee* '. This fee is for the additional exam time and the trial contacts that you will be ' *fitted* ' with. It also includes follow-up appointments as needed until you have been ' *fitted* ' satisfactorily.

The charge for a ' *contact fitting fee* ' is between \$40 and \$50 depending on the lens type. This charge is to be paid at the time of service.

Note: If your vision insurance includes contact lens coverage, your fitting charge *may* be included in the contact lens allowance, depending on the insurance benefit schedule.
